a) **Steve Mattson, Northland Securities, Incorporated**

Steve Mattson, Northland Securities, Incorporated, presented the City of Winsted's Brokerage Account Statement for the City Hall Bond investments for the year 2010.

Quast asked if the City would be penalized if they sell any of the securities before their call date. Mattson stated no; but, the value the City would receive depends on the interest rate at the time of the sale.

Mochinski asked how they are going to make snowmobilers aware that Winsted Lake is aerated. Guggemos stated that there will be a map for all Snow Fun Run participants and Winsted Lake will be designated as a hazardous area.
