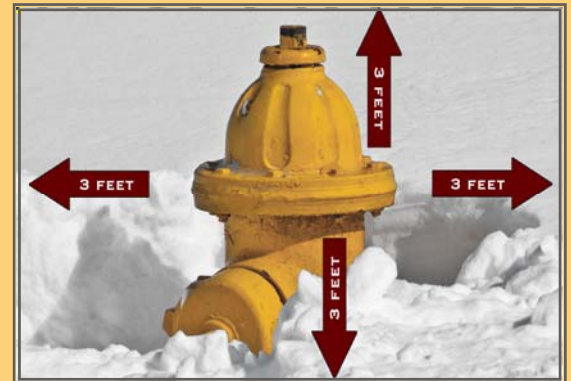


DON'T FORGET TO SHOVEL OUT FIRE HYDRANTS!

Please be a good neighbor and “adopt” a hydrant near your home or business to keep it clear of snow and ice this winter, making sure it is accessible after each snowfall.

If a hydrant is buried, it takes a firefighter valuable time and energy to shovel it out to gain access while a fire continues to burn. It is important to keep these clear of snow and ice, so firefighters don't lose precious time shoveling when they arrive.

Minimally, make sure the hydrant is cleared of snow... enough to be visible from the street. Even better, clear the snow three feet all around the hydrant so firefighters have enough room to connect a hose.



If a resident is physically unable to shovel a hydrant on their property, they are encouraged to ask a neighbor to help out.

Winter Parking Reminder

The winter parking ordinance is in effect from November 1st through March 31st, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. & 6:00 a.m. In accordance with City of Winsted Ordinance 502.008, parking is not permitted on any street in the City of Winsted during this time period.

Vehicles that are parked on the street and in violation of this ordinance will be issued a citation and may be towed at the owner's expense. This information is only posted on City entrance signs and not within the City, so be aware of this parking ban and inform others. Keeping the roadways free of parked vehicles will assist the Public Works Department in clearing snow and ice during winter storms.

Reminder for Dog Owners

If you have not picked up your 2017 dog license, now is the time! All dogs must be licensed within the City of Winsted.

Dog licenses must be renewed each year and are valid from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

A dog license application form is available on the City's website, or at City Hall.

Licenses will not be issued without a current rabies vaccination certificate.

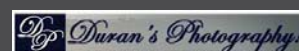
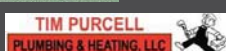
