

## SECTION 4

### 504.000. VEHICLE PARKING.

- 504.001. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, whether attended or unattended, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device in any of the following places:
- A. On a sidewalk or boulevard between sidewalk and roadway.
  - B. In front of a public or private driveway.
  - C. Within an intersection.
  - D. Within 20 feet of a fire hydrant.
  - E. On a crosswalk.
  - F. Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection.
  - G. Within 30 feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic-control signal located at the side of a roadway.
  - H. Alongside any construction or repair work where part of the street is occupied, or opposite any street evacuation or obstruction when such stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic.
  - I. No person shall move a vehicle not owned by such person into any prohibited area or away from a curb such distance as is lawful.
  - J. No person shall, for camping purposes, leave or park a house trailer on or within the limits of any street or highway or on any street or highway right of way except where signs are erected designating the place as a camp site.
  - K. No person shall park a vehicle so as to block a fire escape or the exit from any building, whether on public or private property.
  - L. No person shall park any vehicle where temporary signs are posted reading "No Parking-Police Order" as long as such signs are in place.
  - M. No person shall stop or park a vehicle on a street or highway when directed or ordered to proceed by any peace officer invested by law with authority to direct, control or regulate traffic.
  - N. No person shall place any vehicle on a highway to display the same for sale or exchange. A vehicle shall be deemed to be displayed in violation of this section when found standing upon a street, and bearing a sign indicating that it is for sale or exchange.

- O. No person shall wash, grease or repair such vehicle upon a street or highway, except such repairs as are necessitated by an emergency.
- P. No person shall park a vehicle or permit it to stand, except as otherwise provided, or unless permitted so to do by a police officer, on any street where the City Council has established and marked a "No Parking Zone" and when marked by signs or yellow curb.
- Q. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall prohibit diagonal parking at such places and in such manner as may be established by the City Council and indicated and marked on the roadways and curbs in the highways of this Village.
- R. Wherever and whenever such spaces are so marked, the driver or person in charge of any vehicle shall not park or stand his vehicle in any other manner than that indicated by such markings.
- S. Upon those streets which have been marked or signed for angle parking, vehicles shall be parked at the angle to the curb indicated by such marks or signs.
- T. Vehicles other than trucks shall be not parked in public alleys, and trucks shall not be so parked for a longer period of time than is necessary to load or unload commodities, and then not to exceed thirty minutes.
- U. Vehicles shall not double park on any highway in this village, except trucks when calling for or delivering merchandise, and when access to the curb at or immediately adjacent to the place of delivery is blocked by other vehicles, and then only for such length of time as may be necessary to load or unload, such length of time in any event not to exceed fifteen minutes; and no motor vehicle, commercial or pleasure, shall double park in any area designated by the City Council as "No Parking".
- V. No person shall molest any vehicle standing on any "No Parking" street without the consent of the owner or driver of such vehicle, nor shall any such person set such vehicle in motion or otherwise damage or interfere with the same.
- W. Provided, however, that whenever the City Marshall or any of his assistants shall find it necessary, for purposes of facilitating street maintenance operations, such as the removal of snow, ice, or street wastes, to move any vehicle standing on any street in this village, said City Marshall, or assistants, or other emergency officials in the discharge of their duties, are hereby authorized to move such vehicle to the extent necessary for such purposes.

Every person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than 90 days.
